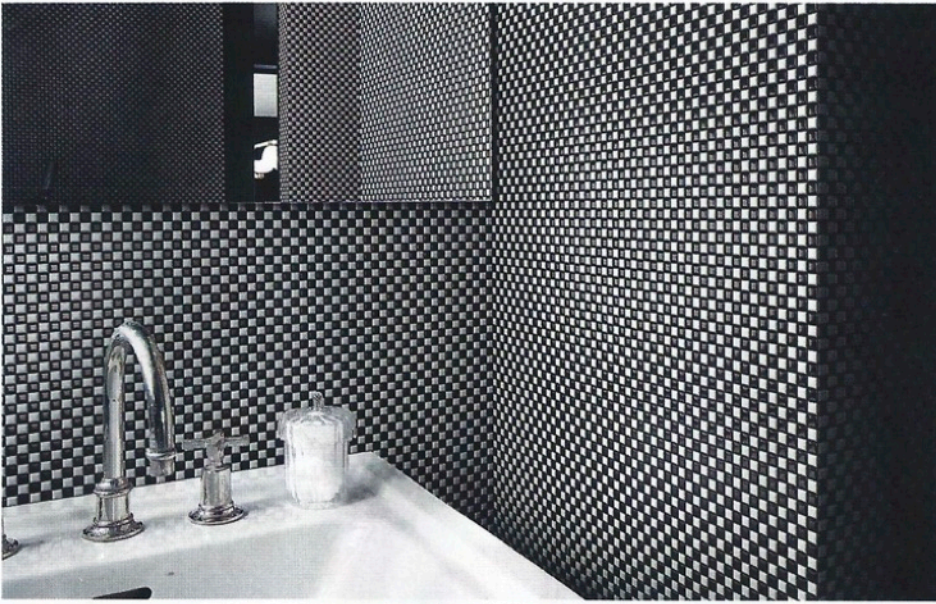


Texture
